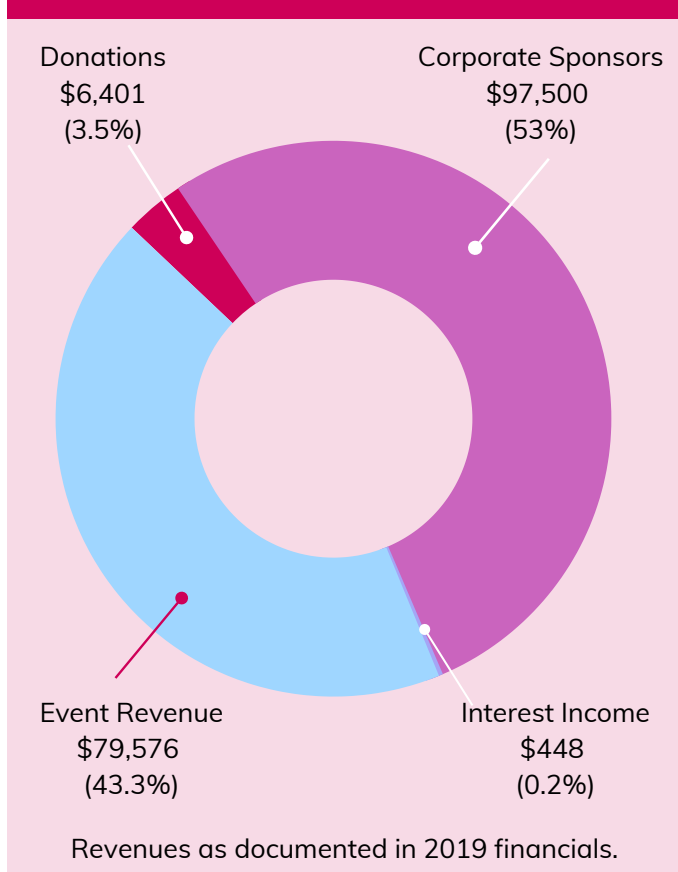
To build a society without boundaries for women by developing the leadership skills of Canadian girls in the spirit of the Famous Five

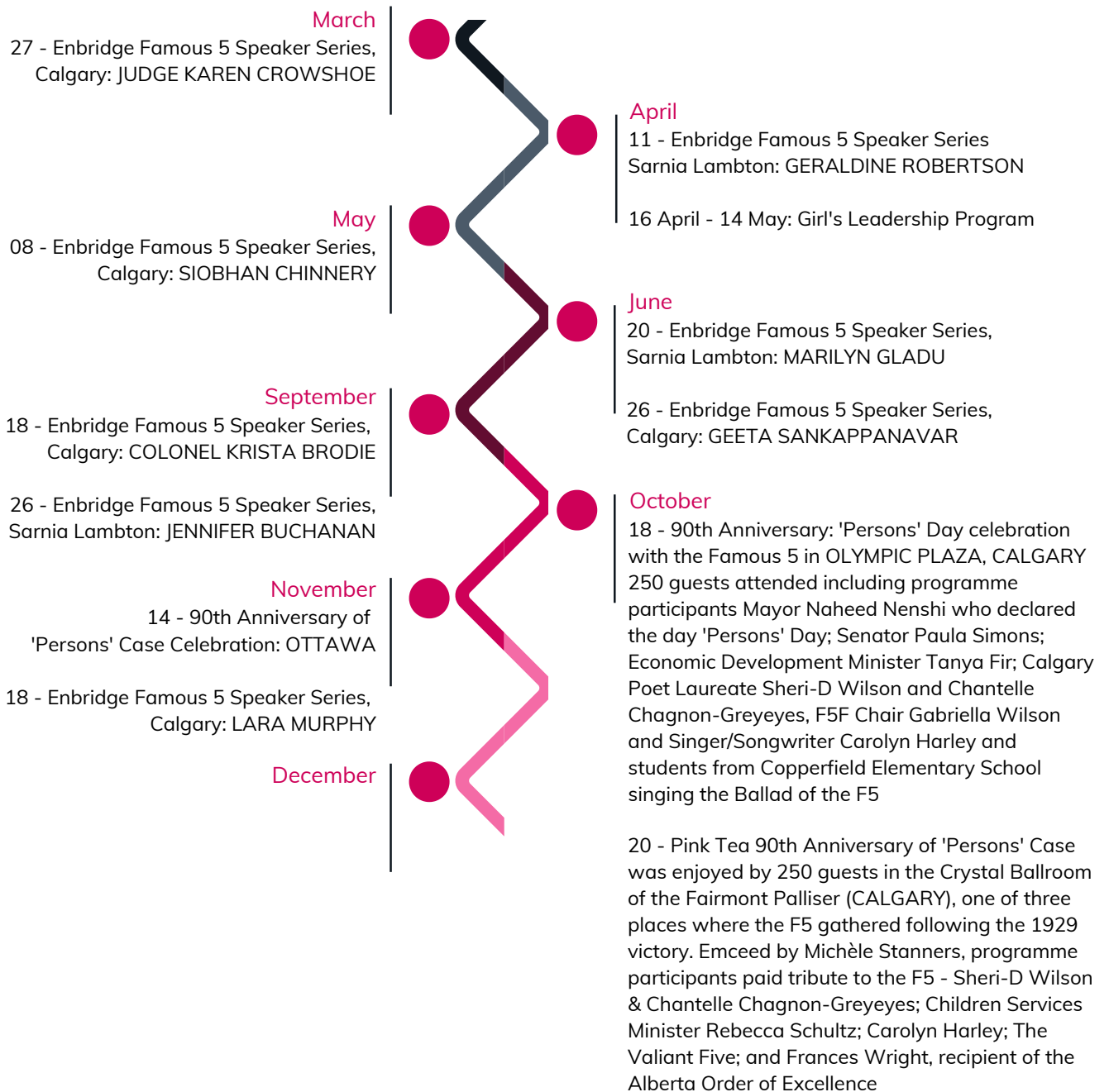
